

COMPETITION RULES

ALL RIDERS PLEASE NOTE:

The minimum hat standard is BSEN 1384 and PAS 015 is compulsory for all riders . All riders wishing to compete must wear hats complying with the new British Standard.

Hats to current standards must be worn and fastened at all times when mounted.

Reservation of right:-

The organiser has the right to

- a) Cancel any class or event
- b) Divide any class
- c) Alter any advertised times
- d) Refuse any entry

The organiser of this event has taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, please take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring.

The organisers ask you to obey the following points:

- a) Watch out for horses
- b) Please do not drop litter or cigarette ends.
- c) Please do not leave children or horses unattended
- d) Dogs must be kept on leads at all times
- e) Please park tidily
- f) Please clean up your horses droppings/mess before you leave.
- g) NO LUNGEING
- h) No smoking in the yard area
- i) No horses under the age of 4
- j) No Stallions

Please note that BD rules will apply to classes with regards to tack fitting - with a modification to the dress code. Please note the required hat ruling above, and if you do not own a correct riding jacket a smart jumper or sweat-shirt may be worn over a shirt and tie/stock. Correct footwear must be worn. Horses do not necessarily need to be plaited, but must be well turned out.

TRAILBLAZERS DRESSAGE.

There are 3 levels of dressage comprising Preliminary, Novice and Elementary in both Juniors and Seniors. The maximum number of British Dressage (BD) points permitted at Trailblazers 2nd Rounds and Finals will be increased to 20 points for Prelim level, 100 points for Novice level and 150 points for Elementary level. BD points allowed in the 1st rounds are at the discretion of the Centre.

CLARIFICATION OF HEIGHTS AND AGES.

Juniors riding ponies/horses. Rider up to 16 years of age and not to have attained their 17th birthday on the first day of the National Championship Show. Seniors riding horses/ponies must have attained their 17th birthday on the first day of the National Championship Show.

HOW TO QUALIFY FOR THE SECOND ROUNDS.

At Trailblazers first round dressage competitions, competitors are awarded a qualification pack towards the second round competitions, if they achieve 58% and over.

SECOND ROUND DRESSAGE.

Every centre can run only one Second Round at each level they have run 1st rounds at over the series, and you need to have qualified at that level to enter. If you have qualified at that level and taken up that Qualification you can choose which centre you wish to go to for your Second Round, it does not have to be the centre you qualified at. It does not matter what test you qualified at in the 1st round it is the level you have qualified at. Centres can choose what tests they run at their 2nd rounds, but you need to enter the level you have qualified at i.e. preliminary, Novice or Elementary.

QUALIFICATION AT THE SECOND ROUNDS FOR SPILLERS® NATIONAL DRESSAGE CHAMPIONSHIPS.

The top 6 competitors qualify from each level both junior and senior for the 2013 finals.

Restricted and open sections on all classes

Please ensure you state clearly on the entry form what section you want to be in. Competitors may only enter either open or restricted.

Restricted Sections

Glebe Farm Walk and trot tests = Restricted to nervous or novice horse and riders who have never won a dressage test before.

BD Intro Tests = Restricted to nervous or novice horse and riders never to have won a dressage test before.

Preliminary tests = Restricted to any horse and rider combination not to have been placed 1st 2nd 3rd in any dressage test except BD intro tests and GFEC walk and trot tests.

Novice tests = Restricted to any horse and rider combination not to have been placed 1st 2nd 3rd in any novice test or above. Horses with BD points may not enter restricted classes.

Elementary tests = Restricted to any horse and rider combination not to have been placed 1st 2nd 3rd in any elementary test or above. Horses with BD points may not enter restricted classes.

Open Sections

Any horse and rider combination may compete in this section.

Dressage Times

Times will be displayed 24 hours before the show on our website, you may call for dressage times on the Saturday before a Sunday show between 9am and 4pm only. For a Wednesday show you may call on the Tuesday before the show between 9am and 4pm only. Please call 01933 666034.

Rosettes

Rosettes are awarded in each class from 1st to 6th. Champion and reserve champion will be awarded rosettes and trophies.
